

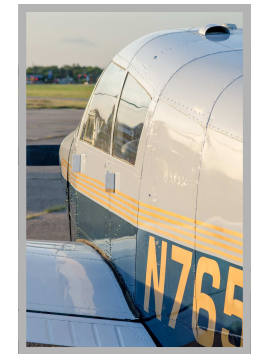
# WIN YOUR OWN PLANE!

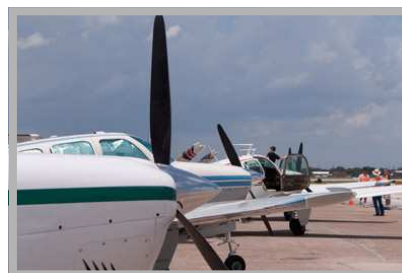
